*On January 12th Jill and Heather presented 2 of the Futbols to this school teacher (who told us his name was "Mister Jim!") at the remote village of Ounianga Kabir in the Ennedi Plateau region of the Sahara desert. He told us they had 200 students and they would make very good use of these Futbols, he was amazed to realize they did not need to pump them up with air!*

*Ounianga Kabir is a very poor village, and it borders a large salt water lake. There are 15 salt water lakes and one fresh water lake in this area, a very unusual feature in a desert. For many centuries camel laden salt caravans would travel from this area taking salt from an evaporation process to far regions of the Sahara and trade for dates and other goods.*

*Of the original 100 Futbols BBE helped us with, we have two left and we promised the children there that I would bring them these last Futbols this week!*
